A-	Gender-neutral option, provider certification required (4 states)	Colorado (2018), Indiana (2019), Pennsylvania (2019)
B+	Easy-to-understand form, certification from a range of licensed professionals (11 states + 1 territory)	Alaska (2012), Connecticut (2013), Delaware (2011), Missouri (2016), New Jersey (2009), New Mexico (2010), North Carolina (2019), Ohio (2019), Puerto Rico (2016), Virginia (2012), Wyoming (2017)
B	Easy-to-understand form, certification by a limited range of licensed professionals (2 states)	Nebraska (2010), West Virginia (2015)
C+	No form, no requirement of proof of surgery or court order; certification from medical/mental health professional (6)	Arizona (1995), Florida (2011), Idaho (2013), Kansas (2011), New York (1987), Wisconsin
C	Burdensome process requirements but does not require proof of surgery, court order, or amended birth certificate (2)	Michigan (requires updated passport), Utah (must provide an updated passport or birth certificate, has an X option)
D	Unclear, unknown or unwritten policy (4 states + 4 territories)	Mississippi, Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota, American Samoa, Guam, Northern Marianas Island, U.S. Virgin Islands
F	Proof of surgery, court order, or amended birth certificate required (9 states)	Alabama, Georgia, Iowa, Kentucky, Louisiana, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas
